

Goal and Objectives



- Goal: Efficient management structure that implements coastwide measures, providing equitable and sustainable access to the resource throughout the management unit in a timely manner
- This goal is supported by a flexible management system that includes:
 - A harvest specification procedure
 - Measures allowing for sustainable harvest
 - Monitoring
 - Protections for recruits

Harvest Specification Process



- Coastwide Specs set up to 3 years
 - Total Harvest Quota
 - Vessel, possession or bag limits
 - Minimum size limits
 - Commercial closure triggers

- Allocation
 - 92% Recreational
 - 8% Commercial

Recreational Fishery



- 36" min size, 1 fish per person, no more than 6 fish per vessel
- State Specific Seasons
- RHL, currently derived from CMP FMP recreational ACL, allocated as state harvest targets (with 1% de minimis set aside, 222 fish)
 - Landings evaluated against targets as 3-year averages

Commercial Management Measures



- 33" FL or 37"TL min size, 2 fish possession, not to exceed the vessel limit of 6 fish.
- Coastwide Quota of 50,000 lbs (3% to de minimis states)
- Closure of the Quota based on trigger

Recommendation for Federal Waters



- Enforce recreational measures to the vessel state of landing
- Enact a commercial closure in federal waters to mirror any coastwide state closure.



CHTS Recreational Fishery








FES Recreational Fishery
